What is faith? - Part 5: Faith without works; works ...

In James chapter 2, James writes that "as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead.". Here James affirms that deeds (or actions) are the byproduct of a living faith. Works do not justify us or make us righteous before God, nor are they the means to salvation. Rather, our deeds are the fruit that grows from one who is obedient to God's commands and transformed by His grace.

Answer: James says, "For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also" (James 2:26). Faith without works is a dead faith because the lack of works reveals an unchanged life or a spiritually dead heart. Jesus said that people would know His followers by their love (John 13:35). In this way we are a light to the world (Matthew 5:14). Good works, then, demonstrate the veracity of our faith and the character of the God in Whom we believe. Faith without works is dead because true faith transforms a life. It is also true that works without faith are dead.

What does it mean that faith without works is dead?

Paul famously writes that "a person is justified by faith apart from the works of the law." But James writes that "a person is considered righteous by what they do and not by faith alone" and that "faith without works is dead."

Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. 19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble! 20 But do you want to know, O foolish man, that faith without works is dead? 21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar?
