STANDARDS OF PRACTICE FOR NEPHROLOGY SOCIAL WORK

The guidelines state that social workers are to establish the tenor of professional relationships by establishing appropriate professional boundaries, declaring conflicts of interest, avoiding dual and multiple relationships with clients, avoiding romantic and sexual relationships with clients, and not exploiting professional relationships (CASW, 2005).
