The 2018-19 Budget - Estimates

The Final Budget Outcome for 2018-19 was a \$13.8 billion improvement compared with the underlying cash deficit estimated at the time of the 2018-19 Budget. This was the result of higher total receipts of \$11.5 billion and lower total payments of \$6.6 billion.

Final Budget Outcome 2018-19

The net capital receipts for 2018-19 have been estimated at Rs 443.1 billion against the budget estimates of Rs 552.5 billion in 2017-18 i.e. a decrease of 19.8%. The total outlay of budget 2018-19 isRs 5,932.5 billion. This size 16.2% higher than the size of budget estimates 2017-18.
